

School-Based Health Centers

Pendleton Community Care in Pendleton County Schools

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Pendleton Community Care is pleased to offer medical, health education, and behavioral health counseling services to all Pendleton County students through school-based health centers.

- Services offered through the school-based health centers are confidential. Health center records are kept by PCC, separate from your child's school record.
- Services provided in the school-based health centers are billed the same way they would be if these services were provided at PCC or the North Fork Clinic. Unless you indicate otherwise on the consent form, you will be contacted prior to a billable service being delivered to your child. You have the option to name another individual to consent to a service in case you cannot be reached. You also have the option to agree ahead of time to all medical services without further contact.

If you would like your child to be able to receive services at school, please sign the consent form and return it to your child's school. Note that even if you select Option 3, indicating that you do not require a phone call before a billable service, you may get such a phone call during the first few weeks of school, before we have had time to process all the papers. Also please note that AFTER OCTOBER 1, services cannot be provided without a written consent on file.

Special additional consent is required for behavioral health services. To request such services for your child, contact Jennifer Taylor-Ide at PCC, 304-358-2355. If someone else refers your child for counseling in the school-based health center, you will be contacted before service is provided.

Hours for the school-based health centers differ by school. For more information call PCC or your child's school. You can also visit our website at www.pcc-nfc.org. To schedule an appointment you can call PCC and request a school-based visit.
